

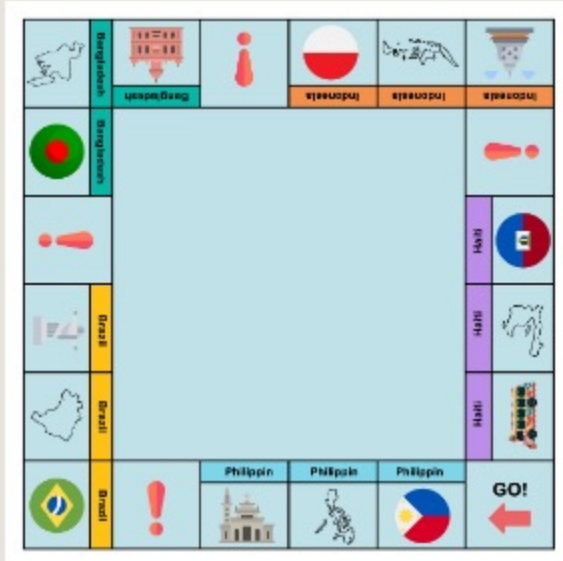
# Planet Defenders

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
**Game Objective:** Explore tropical countries, understand their climate change issues, and collect Solution Cards. The game ends when all Solution Cards are collected, and the player with the most cards wins.

## Game Materials:



## Number of Players: 2

## Game Setup:

- Unfold the game board between the players.
- Place the Issue Cards and solution cards on the side of the board.
- Players choose a piece and place it on the “GO!” block (  ).

## Gameplay:

1. Turn-based action: Players take turns rolling the dice and move their piece along the board's path based on the dice roll.
2. Reaching a Country: When landing on a country's block, players must scan the country on the Issue Card to learn about the specific climate issue of that country.
3. Collecting Solution Cards:
  - a. If the dice roll is above 3, the player receives a Solution Card for that country.
  - b. If the roll is 3 or less, the player does not receive a card.
4. Next Round: After both players have rolled the dice and moved, the round ends, and the next one begins.


## Game End:

- The game ends when all Solution Cards have been collected.

## Winning Condition:

- The player with the most Solution Cards wins.

## Notes:

- If a player lands on a “Chance” block (  ), chance cards will be activated. The player randomly picks up one of the chance cards and follows the instructions to take action.
- From the second round, players can have an additional dice roll chance when land on “Go!”.

### Solution Card (5ps):



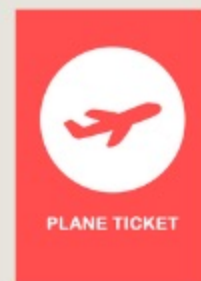
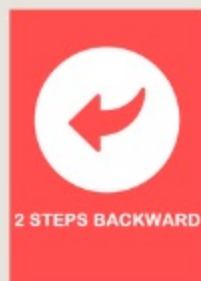
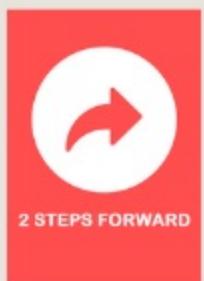
each card provide a accessible solution that improves these climate change risks.
